Behavioral Adaptations

The actions that animals do to survive.

Las acciones que hacen los animales para sobrevivir.

Examples: Bird calls, migration, hibernation

Ejemplos: Cantos de pájaros

Structural adaptations

Physical features that help an organism survive.

Las características físicas que ayudan a un organismo a sobrevivir.

Examples: Respiration, camouflage, movement

Ejemplos: La respiración, el camuflaje, el movimiento

Reproductive adaptations

A change to the reproductive mechanism of an organism that leads to it being a better fit for its environment.

A change to the reproductive mechanism of an organism that leads to it being a better fit for its environment.

Example: Fish lay eggs externally.

Ejemplo: Pescados ponen huevos externamente.

Other vocabulary words

Camouflage: a defense mechanism that allows the organism to change color in order to blend in with their surroundings

(un mecanismo de defensa que permite al organismo a cambiar de color con el fin de armonizar con su entorno)

Hibernation: an inactive state that animals enter to survive the cold winter

(un estado inactivo que los animales entran a sobrevivir el frío invierno)

Fertilization: the way in which the sperm and egg are introduced to create offspring

(la forma En que se introducen los espermatozoides y crear de párrafo descendencia el óvulo)
